
Auguste RODIN (1840 – 1917) The Age of Bronze (Moyen modèle or First réduction)

Conceived in 1875-1876, this reduced version in 1903-1904, this cast in 1944-45 Bronze with nuanced brown patina


Signed Rodin on the terrace along the right side, with the foundry mark Alexis Rudier / Fondeur Paris on the back right and with the inner stamp $104.5 \times 39 \times 32.6$ cm $(41 \times 15\ 1/4 \times 12\ 3/4\ in.)$






